

.10 CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION

A. A certificate of registration:

- (1) Is valid for 2 years from the date of issuance unless suspended or revoked;**
- (2) Remains the property of the Office;**
- (3) Shall be returned to the Office if suspended or revoked;**
- (4) May not be transferred to another person or residence; and**
- (5) Shall include the numbers and ages of children approved for care.**

INTENT: The certificate of registration serves as public verification that you are authorized to operate a family child care home. The certificate is issued to you at your home address. This means that if you move, you must apply for a new certificate of registration.

B. The provider shall display conspicuously the certificate of registration in a location visible to parents whose children are in care or who are considering placing their children in the provider's care.

INTENT: Your certificate must be plainly displayed so that parents and visitors may easily determine that your home is a registered family day care home.

INSPECTION REPORT ITEM: "Certificate conspicuously displayed."

COMPLIANCE CRITERIA: The certificate is displayed plainly and is easily visible from the indoor child care area.

ASSESSMENT METHOD: Observation to determine the location and visibility of the certificate.
