

Sample Selected Response Items for MCAP Social Studies Grade 8 Assessment

One of the item types on the Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) Social Studies Grade 8 assessment is the selected response (SR) question. These items measure students' understanding of United States History content identified in the assessment limits of the grade 8 framework. Below are examples of the formatting for SR question types.

Question 1

Read the excerpt and answer the question.

"I honor those good men and women for their noble daring, and applaud them for willingly subjecting themselves to bloody persecution [mistreatment], by openly avowing [stating] their participation in the escape of slaves . . . "

Which action is Frederick Douglass referring to in this excerpt?

- (A) the establishment of the Ku Klux Klan
- (B) the decision in the *Dred Scott* case
- (C) the passage of the Fugitive Slave Law
- (D) the use of the Underground Railroad

Question 2

Which statement was **most likely** made by a Federalist during the debates over the ratification of the U.S. Constitution?

- (A) "A bill of rights is necessary to protect people's liberties."
- (B) "A strong central government is necessary for our country."
- (C) "The states must retain their original powers."
- (D) "The states must determine whether slavery will exist."
