- A. Principal (Handicapped Facility). The requirements for certification as a principal (handicapped facility) are that the applicant shall:

- B. Supervisor of Special Education (Sole Assignment). The requirements for certification as a supervisor of special education are that the applicant shall:
- (1) Meet the requirements for certification in special education; and
- (2) Meet the requirements for certification as an Administrator I.
- C. Special Provision. Supervisors with multiple area assignments shall meet the requirements set forth in Regulation .04 of this chapter.

Grade Requirements: Each course submitted to fulfill a credit count requirements shall be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

Institution of Higher Education (IHE): An accredited college or university that meets one of the following standards: It is accredited by an accrediting commission in one of the regional associations of colleges and schools; It participates in the ICC or the NCATE programs; or Its course work is accepted by the state in which the institution is located for teacher certification purposes.
