

# Maryland Public Schools Arrest Data

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School Year 2017-2018



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## Introduction

In January 2014, the State Board of Education adopted regulations guiding student discipline. The regulations were designed to keep students in school maintaining progress toward graduation while strengthening school safety. Beginning in the 2015-2016 school year, the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 13A.08.01.12 – Arrests on School Premises, requires annual reporting to the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) school arrests and referrals to law enforcement agencies or the Department of Juvenile Services (DJS).

This report contains data on the number of student arrests in each school system during the 2017-2018 school year. The data includes arrests that occurred as a result of a referral of a student by school personnel to law enforcement or DJS for a disciplinary offense that occurred on school grounds or during off campus activities, including transportation. This report includes both physical and paper arrests. A physical arrest is when a student is physically placed under arrest by a law enforcement official. A paper arrest occurs when there is an officer-initiated referral or request for charges by school officials to DJS (e.g. Juvenile Offense Report, Citation for Court Appearance).

Note: In instances where the number of students in a cell was less than 10, the data were removed and replaced with an asterisk to protect student identity.
