- 8 Maryland schools received this award last year, including three in Montgomery Co, one in Baltimore City and four in PG County

RAP CLUB MENTAL HEALTH PROJECT

- RAP Club is a 12-session trauma-informed group intervention that promotes positive coping and mental wellbeing. The program is intended for universal delivery to 8th graders, not just those with mental health challenges. Core program components include mindfulness practices, CBT skills, and education about the effects of stress on the body. RAP Club reduced PTSD symptoms in a trial conducted across 29 Baltimore City Public Schools, with effects maintained across 12 months during the transition into high school. Boys also experienced improvements in anxiety and behavior problems. In addition, RAP Club had a protective effect during the COVID-19 pandemic: students who had participated in the RAP Club 1-4 years earlier did not experience increased anxiety during the pandemic, whereas students in the control group did.
- Based on these positive program impacts, we are applying for funding for a new study to scale up the program to other districts.
