Maryland's *Excellence in Gifted and Talented Education* (EGATE) Schools 2010-2019



Maryland's education reform agenda focuses on improving all levels of student achievement, including the achievement of students who are advanced /gifted and talented.

Building on a strong foundation of gifted and talented education programs and services currently offered in our schools, in 2010, we began recognizing those schools that are models of excellence.

The Maryland State Department of Education and the State Advisory Council on Gifted and Talented Education initiated the *Excellence in Gifted and Talented Education (EGATE) School Awards Program*. This recognition program honors elementary, middle, and high schools that offer gifted and talented programs aligned with the objectives and criteria of the Maryland *Criteria for Excellence: Gifted and Talented Program Guidelines* and Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 13A.04.07 Gifted and Talented Education

Each EGATE school submitted a comprehensive application, which provided documentation of twenty-one different criteria under four program objectives. The EGATE schools were recognized with Governor's proclamations at a February reception, proudly display the EGATE banner, hosted celebratory visits, and serve as models for other schools seeking to achieve EGATE status. In the first ten years of the program, 83 schools have earned the distinction, of which there were 64 different schools from ten local school systems earned the EGATE designation. Nineteen schools have earned that designation twice.
