 - We are in the visual stage of development. The site was demonstrated highlighting educator and family resources, research, stories, and upcoming events. There are also sections to submit an event, stories, or resources. Different designs and filtering options were shared. A slider of student art will be at the bottom of the screen of the family section. An interactive map of the US allows visitors to click on their state's GT policy. There will be a language translator.
 - Submissions needed for resources by Feb. 28. Very few resources have been 0 submitted at this point. Bruce created a submission form.
