How are credits earned in JSES?

Students in JSES are enrolled in credit-bearing courses based on transcript analysis. Transcripts of students' academic performance with JSES will be transferred to their school systems upon request.

What if I had/have an IEP?

JSES provides a continuum of Special Education Services to meet the needs of each student.

What if I have a 504 Plan?

JSES implements accommodations / modifications within the classroom setting, as outlined in students' 504 Plans.

How do I obtain my GED?

To obtain a Maryland General Education Diploma (GED), a student must be 17 years of age with parental permission; obtain qualifying on GED Ready test; be registered for the official test; and obtain a minimum score of 145 on each subject test area.

What if I already have a GED or High School Diploma?

Upon receipt of diploma, students have the option to prepare for ACT/SAT/Accuplacer Test. JSES has partnerships with community colleges for college course opportunities.
