Purpose

- Districts must administer the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs or WIDA Alternate ACCESS.
- 25,200,000 in FY 2022
 - \$935 for each EL with a composite score of 1.0-1.9
 - \$645 for each EL with a composite score of 2.0-2.9
 - \$105 for each EL with a composite score of 3.0-3.9

 - Required fiscal report on July 15 of each year
 - Adequacy of funds to be reviewed every three years

Allowable/Unallowable Activities

- **Allowable Costs:**

- Direct instruction by ESL- or Bilingual Education-endorsed staff
- Professional Development
- computer assisted instruction
- parent engagement
- the purchase of English Language Development (ELD) instructional materials
- transportation to support extended learning and community activities.

All expenditures are to be directed to the support of ELD and academic content attainment for the eligible students.
