NOTE: Additional \$1,000 for teachers who earn certification from the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS) in Baltimore, Garrett and Worcester counties; \$2,000 in Anne Arundel, Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Frederick, Harford, Howard, Kent, Montgomery, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Washington, and Wicomico counties; \$2,020 in Allegany county; \$2,500 in Calvert and Charles counties; \$3,000 in St. Mary's county; \$4,000 in Baltimore City; \$5,000 in Carroll and Prince George's counties. The Maryland State Department of Education also contributes a stipend of up to \$2,000 a year as a dollar-for-dollar match to local school systems for teachers with NBPTS certification. A \$1,500 stipend is available for classroom teachers who hold an Advanced Professional Certificate (APC) and work in schools identified by the State Board of Education as having comprehensive needs. Teachers must also have a satisfactory performance rating.
