The Earlier, The Better!

IF YOU HAVE CONCERNS, MAKE A REFERRAL TODAY.

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While all children grow and develop at their own rate, some infants and toddlers experience delays in their development, atypical behavior, or have been diagnosed with a special health condition that is likely to lead to non-typical development. The earlier that potential delays and disabilities are identified and early intervention services begin, the better chance a young child has of achieving his or her best potential.

Referrals can be made by anyone for children younger than 36 months who live in Maryland.
