SUBJECT: Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER) State Set Aside

PURPOSE:

To request approval of the spending plans for the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA), and the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) State Set Asides.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA) and the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) were enacted in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. These Acts include several different funding programs that fiscally impact the Maryland State Department of Education and Local School Systems. This presentation reviews the spending plans for the State Set Asides for mentioned federal relief packages associated with the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief funding.

ACTION:

Request approval of Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund II and III State Set Aside spending plan.
