## ORDER

On April 19, 2019, the Maryland State Department of Education issued a denial of a request from Baltimore County Council to exclude from its maintenance of effort school funding amount certain costs which Baltimore County deemed to be non-recurring costs. (Ex.1). On May 28, 2019, Baltimore County appealed that denial to the State Board of Education. (Ex. 2). Pursuant to COMAR 13A.02.05.04, a county or local board may appeal to the State Board within 15 days of the date of a decision to approve or deny a cost as non-recurring.

The appeal was filed 39 days after the decision to deny the costs as non-recurring.

Therefore, it is this 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 2019 by the Maryland State Board of Education, ORDERED, that the appeal be Dismissed as untimely.
