Welcome to the BOOST Scholarship Application! The Broadening Options and Opportunities for Students Today (BOOST) Scholarship program provides scholarships for some students who are eligible for the free or reduced-price school meals ([FARMs](#)) (<https://www.fns.usda.gov/cn/fr-020923>) to attend eligible nonpublic schools. Scholarship awards are granted based on household income, with the lowest income served first. Priority is given to students who received a BOOST award last year, and their sibling(s). Assurances for Parent/Guardian

- I understand and agree that all of my information on this application and attachments are true and complete to the best of my knowledge. If asked by an official, I agree to give additional proof of the information given on this application. ***
- Sharing of Information: I understand that this information may be shared with appropriate BOOST Scholarship Advisory Board members and certain Maryland State Department of Education staff for purposes of administering the program. Also, I agree that this information may be shared with the selected nonpublic school. ***
- Consequences for False Information: I understand that if I purposely give false or misleading information, the scholarship recipient may lose scholarship benefits, and I may be prosecuted under applicable State and Federal laws. ***
- Requirements for Participating Schools: I understand that if the selected nonpublic school does not certify in Fall 2023 that it will administer certain assessments, provide certain assessment results, comply with non-discrimination laws, and comply with other requirements specified in the legislation governing the program, the school will become ineligible to participate in the BOOST Scholarship program for the 2023-2024 school year. In this case, I will be notified via email of the school's ineligibility and given an opportunity to enroll the student at a school that is participating in the BOOST Scholarship program. ***
- Enrollment and Financial Aid Information from Schools: I understand that if my student is awarded a BOOST scholarship, the selected nonpublic school must confirm enrollment of the student at the school. The nonpublic school also is required to provide information to the Maryland State Department of Education on the amount of non-BOOST financial aid received by the student for the 2023-2024 school year, and if the BOOST scholarship plus non-BOOST financial aid exceed the tuition amount owed, the BOOST scholarship will be reduced. ***

Special Education Services: I understand that if my child has an individualized education program (IEP) and I place my child in a nonpublic school through the BOOST scholarship program, the child does not have an individual entitlement to any or all of the services that may otherwise be available under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). *
