- 1-a _____ With meaningful consultation with parents of participating children, each local educational agency must implement programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents and family members.
- 2-a _____ Each Title I school must conduct, with the meaningful involvement of parents and family members, an annual evaluation of the content and effectiveness of the parent and family engagement policy/plan in improving the academic quality of all Title I schools.
- 3-b _____ School parent and family engagement policy/plan may be made available to the local community and updated periodically to meet the changing needs of parents and the school.
- 4-c _____ Each Title I school must involve parents, in an organized, ongoing, and timely ways in the planning, review and improvement of the school parent and family engagement policy/plan and the joint development of the schoolwide program plan under section 1114(b).
- 5-d _____ As a component of the school-level parent and family engagement policy/plan, each Title I school must jointly develop with parents a school-parent compact that outlines how parents, the entire school staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement.
- 6-e _____ Each school and local educational agency must establish a districtwide parent advisory council to provide advice on all matters related to parental involvement in programs supported by Title I.
- 7-f _____ In carrying out the parent and family engagement requirements, local educational agencies and schools, to the extent practicable, must provide opportunities for the informed participation of parents and family members including parents and family members who have limited English proficiency, parents and family members with disabilities, and parents and family members of migratory children.
- 8-g _____ In a State operating program under part E of Title IV, each local educational agency or school that receives assistance under this part may inform parents and organizations of the existence of the program.
- 9-h _____ The State educational agency may review the local educational agency's parent and family engagement policies and practices to determine if the policies and practices meet the requirements specified in Section 1116.
