

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Reporting Requirements

Date	Item
July 2026	Signed assurance page is due SAIs may request initial 25% disbursement of funds (optional) Monitoring visits commence
October 31, 2026	Invoices submitted by this date will be processed in November
January 31, 2027	Invoices submitted by this date will be processed in February Interim Report due (<u>C-1-25C</u>)
April 30, 2027	Invoices submitted by this date will be processed in May
June 30, 2027	Monitoring visits conclude
July 15, 2027	SAIs submit Final invoices to MSDE for expenses incurred
August 15, 2027	Final progress report (<u>C-1-25D</u>) is due Managing for Results (MFR) report is due
