






How would you rate the "Law Presentation" - Margaret-Ann Howie, Esq. - Day 2





How would you rate the "Team Breakout Session" - Day 2 (45 responses)






Content Relevance

I think it was a strong session. I especially enjoyed the segment on legal issues in school. I think it's always a good thing to have legal minds speak to administrators about the most recent updates in school law. This was especially true for transgender and LGBT issues. The session with Dr. Wagner was also helpful, albeit we were very sedentary during the presentation. The budget activities were appropriate and generated a great deal of discussion. As has been the case with each convening, I felt the experience was very valuable.

Thank you for giving us more time to work with our team this session. The budget information was the most helpful for me as I have very little experience in the area. Tom Evans was, as he always is, so helpful with tips and suggestions.

If possible, the law section could be longer to allow for additional questions/scenarios for discussion.

The school law presentation was outstanding. I know that her time is valuable, but I felt that we could have even spent longer with her- maybe even a morning and afternoon session. The issues are so complicated.

This convening was extremely relevant to my current work. Anytime I get to brainstorm with colleagues from across the state is beneficial. We had a great time discussing the variations in budgets from various counties.

The sessions were extremely valuable. Please consider moving the budget work to an earlier convening, as budget time is January/February.

I am grateful for the experience provided to review and analyze school budgets. As assistant principals, we have not been afforded the opportunity to work with school budgets and when interviewing, we are often at a disadvantage because of this.

Practical knowledge like the Budget and Law in schools boosts one's portfolio in our field. The activities through which the material was delivered was ideal and resonant.

I felt that the law presentation and discussion could have been an hour or so longer. Also, would be interesting to have some table time to discuss a case, try to determine what happened and then hear the verdict...

The content was very serious in nature. Having both of these presentations in the same convening left me as well as some group members feeling deflated to a certain degree. I would consider having them at different time. Perhaps the turbulence and the law session can be presented at the same convening in the future.

I thought the reflective practices activity was relevant for our March convening, our last one of the academy. I also felt that the budget and law topics were extremely helpful as they are topics that we often do not have direct experience with as APs.

I really enjoyed the presentation on school law; it was very insightful and helps with some day-to-day decision making.

I believe the March convening was the most valuable of the convening (with exception of Tim Tooten's session). The budget and law sessions presented content and enabled us to engage in dialogue that is relevant to our current work. I am able to use this information as I work alongside my principal to prepare our budget for next school year.

Dr. Henry Wagner's presentation was a great way to reflect on our current situation in school. I felt a wave of heightened motivation after listening to him speak to us about reflection as a leader. Also, the breakout sessions with our team/coach related to budget situations and scenarios was extremely beneficial. When I returned to school on Friday I had a situation related to funds and I was able to answer the questions with more accuracy and confidence.

I felt we needed more time on school law. I was disappointed in not having our sessions in April.

I was disappointed to hear that this was our last meeting. I wish we either knew ahead of time or at least had time to say goodbye to everyone. I felt like it was very rushed at the end to say goodbye to everyone.

I can't say enough about the information that was given. It is extremely valuable, and allows us to delve a lot deeper that what would normally take place at our home school, due to time and normal day to day happenings. It also allows us to hear from colleagues in other Counties, as their budgeting practices and policies may be slightly different, or they have come across some instances that others have not experienced. This type of learning is irreplaceable.

Budget Break out sessions allowed us to look at sample budget and allocate funds. Extremely helpful. Also being able to identify the differences in each county due to the Budget Scavenger Hunt.

Ms. Howie's presentation was very appropriate for me especially with the concerns my district is currently facing. The budgeting activities were also beneficial as I was in the middle of working with my leadership team to allot the SY 17-18 school year.

I found the presentation made by Law Presentation" - Margaret-Ann Howie, Esq. and the Team Breakout Session-Budget Activity to be extremely valuable during this convening. I was familiar with many of the cases shared during the law presentation. However, the presentation served as a refresher to the School Law course I took during graduate school. The information shared regarding Social Media court cases was very valuable. I have had to mediate countless conflicts that have been traced back to social media. The other important take away form the Law Presentation was the importance of documentation when addressing employee unsatisfactory performance. The Team Breakout Session was also very valuable. The information gained from the Student Activity Funds discussion was priceless. It was helpful to hear the experiences shared by the coach as well as my team members. Making sure there are clear articulated procedures for handling money and setting regular scheduled meetings to discuss accounts with anyone who handles school funds are important two take away.

I really enjoyed the budget activity. The homework assignment allowed me to have a conversation with my principal about budget that we had never had before. This was very helpful.



How would you rate the value of this March 2017 convening towards your overall development as a school leader?


