Virtual Community of Practice sessions with expert AIM facilitators focus on hands-on practice to support classroom implementation. All middle and high school educators, English Language Arts and content areas alike, should register for this learning opportunity that develops depth of knowledge around literacy development and proficiency across content areas.
