




Maryland: NAEP and PARCC proficiency rates are similar across all grades and subjects

2017 NAEP and PARCC, percent proficient and above of 4th and 8th graders (Maryland)




Baltimore City: NAEP and PARCC proficiency rates are similar across all grades and subjects

2017 NAEP and PARCC, percent proficient and above of 4th and 8th graders (Baltimore City)



Math 4, Ordered by Unadjusted Average Scale Score




Math 4, Ordered by Adjusted Average Scale Score




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Math 8, Ordered on Unadjusted Average Scale Score




Math 8, Ordered on Adjusted Average Scale Score





Reading 4, Ordered on Unadjusted Average Scale Score




Reading 4, Ordered on Adjusted Average Scale Score





Reading 8, Ordered on Adjusted Average Scale Score




Advanced Placement in Maryland Overview, 2017

- Maryland public school students took a total of 110,846 AP exams
 - Students took about 1,360 more exams than last year
 - 58,981 students took at least one exam, with an average of 1.9 exams each
 - 46.5 percent of Maryland's 2017 graduates took at least one AP exam
- The most popular subject areas are social studies (35,401 exams), science (30,734), and English (22,303)
- The exam pass rate was 63.1 percent (nation: 57.5 percent), an increase of 1.1 percentage points from 2016
- 31.2 percent of graduates passed at least one exam, the second-highest in the nation (nation: 22.8 percent)
- About one-third of districts require students enrolled in AP courses to take the AP exam to receive additional credit in the weighted GPA. The remaining districts encourage or expect students to take the exam, but it is not required to receive weighted credit for taking an AP course.


Maryland's AP exam pass rate increased significantly over the past two years, while student and exam counts remained relatively steady.

AP Exam Participation and Exam Pass Rate, Maryland Public School Students (2017)




Students took the most social studies (35,401), science (30,734), and English (22,303) exams.

Count of AP Exams by Subject Area




Pass rates varied by exam, from 57% (English exams) to 86% (world language exams).


Percent of Exams Scoring 3 or Higher, Maryland Public School Students (2017)



In 2017, AP exams were disproportionately taken by Asian and white students, and not taken by black/African American and Hispanic/Latino students.




In 2017, black/African American students were particularly underrepresented in the share of math, science, and social studies AP exams.



Five Maryland districts are participating in the Lead Higher program to increase the participation of underrepresented, academically-prepared students in AP classes.


- One cohort: Calvert, Dorchester, Prince George's, and Washington Counties
- Two cohorts: Montgomery County
- Over two years, approximately 1,520 qualified students in 20+ participating schools have been identified and enrolled in AP classes

2017 AP exam pass rates for all Maryland students varied by student group. Rates ranged from 74% (Asian students) to 36% (black/African American students).



By local agency, in 2017 the percent of AP exams scoring 3 or higher ranged from about 30 percent to nearly 80 percent.


Percent of AP Exams Scoring 3 or Higher, 2017




ACT in Maryland Overview, 2017

- 17,179 Maryland high school graduates took the ACT in 2017
- The average ACT comprehensive score was 23.6 (nation: 21.0)
- 77 percent of ACT takers met the English benchmark, 64 percent met reading, 60 percent met math, 54 percent met science, and 44 percent met all four

ACT participation of high school graduates and average score has increased over the past five years.



ACT participation varies by student group. Black/African American and Hispanic students are underrepresented among test takers.




SAT in Maryland Overview, 2017

- 42,919 Maryland high school graduates took the SAT in 2017
- The average SAT score was 1060 (nation: 1060)
- 48 percent of graduates who took the SAT met the math benchmark, and 70 percent met the reading and writing benchmark
- Because of significant redesigns to the SAT test, trend lines are not available
- In 2017-18, eight LEAs administered the SAT to all juniors, with an additional LEA scheduled for 2018-19

Percent of Students Meeting Test Benchmarks, ELA




National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) Data

- MSDE has a contract with the National Student Clearinghouse to report the number and percentage of Maryland graduating students who enroll in a public or non-public college within 12, 16, or 24 months of high school graduation, nationwide
 - Colleges elect to participate in NSC
 - NSC participants enroll 98 percent of all students nationwide
- MSDE provides reports based on NSC data to local education agencies and the public

Nationwide college enrollment rates vary by time-since-graduation and student group




